Frightened Rabbit's art council grand tour reaches the Tolbooth

A SCOTISH rock band with its roots in Selkirk gets its biggest exposure to date with a tour that includes a Stirling date next week.

Frightened Rabbit have proven something of a slow burner from beginnings in 2003 when it was the stage moniker of solo singer-guitarist Scott Hutchison through the follow-

ing year when drummer brother Grant came on board and then 2006 with Billy Kennedy on guitar.

With a debut album released the same year the group's sound has developed even further following recruitment of Andy Monaghan on keyboards and bassist Gordon Skene.

Frightened Rabbit are building up a real fanbase and are now heading out across the country supported by the Scottish Arts Council's Tune Up programme and their gig at Stirling's Tolbooth next Saturday (November 28) will see them premier tracks from their new album.
