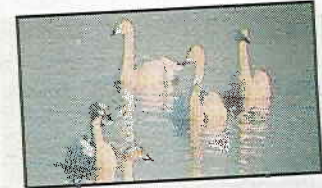
**3** **GRAEME STEPHEN SEPTET**
