### Voyage de Nuit

IRISH FLUTES AND FLAMENCO guitars are not the most readily compatible sounds. Yet hitting the road – and a few island ferries – next week is the Celtic-flamenco fusion of Voyage de Nuit. The ensemble, embarking on a Scottish Arts Council-sponsored Tune Up tour, features the Edinburgh-based Irish flautist and singer Nuala Kennedy with Azulejos, the flamenco-jazz outfit led by the French guitarist and composer Philippe Guidat. Azulejos's tour line-up includes Guidat's regular percussionist, the Bolivian Diego Landivar, Kennedy's frequent collaborator, the English



accordionist Luke Daniels, and Scots-based Brazilian double-bassist, Mario Caribe.
