**Radio was once the only global medium but now in the age of the internet we have web-radio, TV and global mobile telephony. RADIO SPACE is an attempt to explore what radio has to offer us at a time when communication is so much simpler, but can be homogenised, institutionalised and controlled? Where are the personal connections, the spirit of discovery?**

RADIO SPACE is a TUNE UP tour working with micro-radio, (radio with the power to transmit to one house, a block of flats, a bar, or to an audience: a utterly personal interaction with cutting edge art), to explore the relationship to our locale, between performer and audience, between the ‘transmitter’ and ‘receiver’.

The tour is being developed by Arika, creators and producers of some of the most exiting experimental music and film projects in the UK and Resonance 104.4 fm, London’s first radio art station; a radical alternative to the universal formulae of mainstream broadcasting. Both Arika and Resonance 104.4fm are create projects that open up experimental approaches to music to a wide audience.

They’re working with leading experimental musicians and radio artists Tetsuo Kogawa, Knut Aufermann and Sarah Washington to develop the tour and will be bringing on board more artists in the coming weeks. Keep an eye on our websites for updates on how the project is progressing.

Barry Esson (of Arika) has said: “We’re really excited to be working with Tune Up again on another tour: it allows us to think about why artists should tour, what it is in each location that should interest them, and how audiences interact with art in their own towns, cities or countryside: why does it have to be on a stage, in a ‘venue’? It’s a great way of artistically celebrating location. Radio Space should be a unique, surprising and rewarding celebration of radio; a new way for lots of people to think about communication and a great way to take experimental artists around Scotland.”
